


Context

The article effects of nonverbal parameters on teaching communication in preschool education.



Highlights how non-verbal communication of teachers can make didactic communication more efficient.



Methods

Questionnaire-based survey method



 Participants 64 teaching staff state preschool educational institutions



Google Form received by e-mail / WhatsApp



Results

Teachers greater importance to nonverbal elements such as:

gestures & mimicry, intonation & tone of speech



the elements related to proxemics & dressing-code.



When a child becomes careless or turbulent, the teacher nonverbal channels.



Conclusions

Non-verbal elements most often used by the educators are eye contact and voice modulation.



These elements are not used by chance, but are introduced consciously and systematically by the educators in the teaching activity, they are aware of their educational value.
