Fostering Integration of Education for Sustainable Development into the Educational Practice

State of the Art

ESD is considered a catalyst for transforming individuals and society, offering values and competences that will contribute to building a sustainable future.

The main aim of this research has in view the identification of the proper entry points into the educational practice which must be used by all teachers to obtain a literacy for sustainability for their pupils.



This research introduces an original concept that may integrate ESD in the teaching activity of teachers from lower secondary education and is based on the incorporation of all dimensions of ESD in educational practice.



Research Methods:

- Critical analysis and reflection.
- Identifying the best set of entry points, designed on the three dimensions of the sustainable development.
- Designing the framework for the development of empathy, solidarity, and mobilization (ESM) on a 3×3 matrix of main entry points.
- Assessing the relevance and main potential results of applying the ESM set.

Result 1:

The identification of the main entry points organised on each dimension of sustainable development.

Result 2:

The identification of the main entry points with the actual potential key transformative shifts in pupils & how it may lead to awareness, understanding and application of the knowledge on everyday activities of the children.

Result 3:

The identification of the correlation of the main entry points with the actual potential key transformative shifts in pupils which may transform them into more responsible persons.
