State of the Art

A content analysis was then performed for **four subjects**:
Educational Psychology, Pedagogy I Pedagogy II, and Teaching Practice.

Result 1:

Inclusive education was not identified as a distinct subject in the **core curriculum**.

Result 2:

Inclusion should be a **fundamental component** of teachers' training.

Result 3:

Specific contents were identified within **four subjects** as potential entry points for inclusive education.
